#### Lang. Arts: Reader's Workshop-

We will work on lesson #9 for Reading. We will study abstract nouns,

We will continue Unit 2. They will use the order of operations following the acronym PEMDAS (parentheses, exponents, multiply, divide, add, subtract). This will help with two or multistep equations and word problems.
