# $3^{\text {rd }}$ Grade <br> Grading System 

Your child's work will be graded using the numbers 4, 3, 2, and 1 in alignment with the report cards. Level 4 means advanced (exceeds grade level expectations), Level 3 means proficient (meets grade level expectations), Level 2 means partially proficient (below grade level expectations), and Level 1 means not proficient (little/no evidence of content or skill). The following shows the various levels, percentage range and the grade equivalents.

Level $4=95 \%-100 \%---A$
Level 3= 75\%-94\%---C, C+, B-, B, B+, A-
Level $2=60-74 \%---D-, D, D+, C-$
Level $1=0 \%-59 \%---F$
