Lang. Arts: Reader's Workshop-

We will begin Lesson #16 for Reading. We will focus on the weekly spelling with "air," "ear," and "are," words. We will also focus on the vocabulary connecting to the main story "Judy Moody Saves the World" and paired text "My Smelly Pet." We will study story structure and theme, context clues, adjectives and articles, monitoring/clarifying the text, and using intonation when we read.

Writing: Writer's Workshop

We will continue and finish our Research and Informational Writing with Animal Report. We will then study "Opinion Writing: Persuasive Letter" and think about our purpose.

Math: Time

We will continue and finish the telling time portion of Unit 3. At the end of the week we will review measure, graphs, and time to prepare for the Unit 3 Test on Monday, March 26th.

Social Studies: Michigan
