## Using Our Brain Energy!

### Lang. Arts: Reader's Workshop-

This week we work on Lesson 7 for Reading. We will focus on the weekly spelling with three-letter clusters (spelled with scr, spr, str, and thr). We will also focus on the vocabulary connecting to the main story "What Do Illustrators Do?" and paired text "Jack Draws a Beanstalk", and past, present, and future tense with verbs. We will also discuss sequencing events, text/graphic features, and reading with expression.

**Spelling: Test scheduled for Wednesday, November 15<sup>th</sup>**  
Habit #2-"Begin With the End in Mind" will be the focus.

### Writing: Writer's Workshop

This week's focus continues to be with Narrative Writing. We will think about how to prewrite a personal narrative and develop ideas in an organized way.

### Math: Multiplication & Division

We will begin Unit 2 later in the week, which will focus on patterns with 6s, 7s, and 8s.

We will also begin looking at how to solve two-step word problems.

Timed tests are every Wednesday, so please study!

### Social Studies: Michigan

The students will continue to focus on the vegetation and climate of Michigan and work in collaborative groups to complete a state symbols project.

### Science: Solid Earth

We will continue to study the Rock Cycle and Every day Treasure (how rocks are used in the work). We will read informational text, answer questions, and work on a flip book to organize our thinking.
