Lang. Arts: Reader's Workshop-

This week we work on Lesson 5 for Reading. We will focus on the weekly spelling with long "i" vowel patterns (spelled with igh, i, and ie). We will also focus on the vocabulary connecting to the main story "Roberto Clemente" and paired text "Baseball Poems", and plural nouns with -s and -es endings. We will also discuss cause and effect and visualization and intonation as a fluency skill.

Writing: Writer's Workshop
