Lang. Arts: Reader's Workshop-

This week we work on Lesson 4 for Reading. We will focus on the weekly spelling with long "o" vowel patterns (spelled with oa, o, and ow). We will also focus on the vocabulary connecting to the main story "Pop's Bridge" and paired text "Bridges", and the difference between common and proper nouns. We will also discuss how to infer and predict, look at story structure, compare and contrast, and using expression as a fluency skill.

Writing: Writer's Workshop

This week's focus continues to be with Narrative Writing. We will think about how to prewrite a personal narrative and develop ideas in an organized way.

Math: Multiplication & Division

We will continue to explore multiplication and division. We will look at patterns and practice the 3s, 4s, and multiplication and area with models.

Social Studies: Michigan

The students will continue to explore Michigan. We will look at the Natural Characteristics which include: Landforms and Bodies of Water.

Science: Solid Earth

We will complete the Natural Causes that Change Earth's Surface concept book and begin to study the 3 Types of Rocks (metamorphic, igneous, and sedimentary).
