Lang. Arts: Reader's Workshop-

This week we will continue and finish Lesson 2 for Reading. We will focus on the weekly spelling with long vowel patterns, vocabulary connecting to the main story "The Trial of Cardigan Jones", and kinds of sentences. We will also discuss how to infer and predict, look at conclusions and author's word choices, and using phrasing as a fluency skill.

Spelling: Test on Wednesday, October 4th Habit #1-"Be Proactive" will be the focus.

Writing: Writer's Workshop

This week's focus is on Narrative Writing. We will think about how to write descriptive paragraphs with dialogue and use the trait of conventions in our writing.

Math: Multiplication & Division
