This week we work on Lesson 5 for Reading. We will focus on the weekly spelling with long "i" vowel patterns (spelled with igh, i, and ie). We will also focus on the vocabulary connecting to the main story "Roberto Clemente" and paired text "Baseball Poems", and plural nouns with -s and -es endings. We will also discuss cause and effect and visualization and intonation as a fluency

Writing: Writer's Workshop

This week's focus continues to be with Narrative Writing. We will think about how to prewrite a personal narrative and develop ideas in an organized way.

Math: Multiplication & Division

We will continue to explore multiplication and division. We will look at patterns 4s, 0s, and 1s, and build fluency skills using word problems and strategy cards.

Social Studies: Michigan

The students will focus on the vegetation and climate of Michigan and work in collaborative groups to complete a state symbols project.

Science: Solid Earth

We will study the 3 Types of Rocks (metamorphic, igneous, and sedimentary). We will read informational text, answer questions, and work on a flip book to organize our thinking.
