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Using Our Brain Energy!

Lang. Arts: Reader's Workshop-

This week we will begin Lesson 2 for Reading. We will focus on the weekly spelling with long vowel patterns, vocabulary connecting to the main story "The Trial of Cardigan Jones", and kinds of sentences. We will also discuss how to infer and predict, look at conclusions and author's word choices, and using phrasing as a fluency skill.

Spelling: Please see weebly for spelling and vocabulary words Habit #1-"Be Proactive" will be the focus.

Writing: Writer's Workshop

This week's focus is on Narrative Writing. We will think about how to write a descriptive paragraphs with dialogue and use the trait of conventions in our writing.

Math: Multiplication & Division

We will focus on exploring division and the vocabulary: dividend, divisor, and quotient. We will also make connections between multiplication and division. We will also explore patterns with 2s and 10s and how to use a Target Box to help with our facts.

Please practice 5s and 2s facts at home.

Social Studies: Michigan

The students will begin studying what a geographer is and what you study when you look at the geography of a place. We will focus on "Location." Students will use directions on a compass to name locations, know the difference between absolute and relative location, and describe the relative location of Michigan.

Science: Solid Earth

We will explore and discuss the layers of the earth (inner core, outer core, mantle, and crust).
